PRESIDENT'S REPORT

2017 has been a busy year, highlighted by the reunion held in Brisbane 17-21 May this year. Our Patron MAJGEN Mick Slater DSO, DSC, CSC (Retd) as well as the new CO 2RAR, LTCOL Doug Pashley and the RSM WO1 Trent Morris, attended the reunion. The reunion committee worked very hard to ensure this event was as good, if not better, than the one held in Townsville some five years ago. For those here that attended, I'm sure you'll agree that it was a most successful and enjoyable four-day event.

A number of our members were recognised during the reunion dinner for their exceptional contribution to the Association. I would like to congratulate Arthur Macdonald for being awarded Life membership for his continued dedicated service to the Association. Wally Musgrave, Terry Dinneen and Margaret Gibbons were presented with the Silver Soldier for their longstanding contribution and commitment to the 2RAR Association. Congratulations to all four members for their outstanding service.

The Management Committee has decided to develop a series of Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs). The committee uses these SOPs as a means of achieving commonality in the operation of the Association, to assist in meeting statutory requirements and to assist committee members to fulfill their responsibilities within the committee. These SOPs will also allow a much easier transition when a new member is appointed to a position within the committee.

Congratulations to 2RAR for taking out the Duke of Gloucester Cup this year. Additionally, 2RAR also took out the Sir Arthur MacDonald Trophy (best section in foundation warfighting) and the Gurkha Trophy (best section for overall shooting). Soldiers from 2RAR took first place, Cpl Liam Kiernan and second place, Pte Tom Florence in the DSM Roche CSC Memorial Cup for the best individual soldier. An excellent outcome and the Battalion is commended for this outstanding result.

WO1 Trent Morris, RSM 2RAR, will be leaving the Battalion at the end of the year. WO1 Morris has always been very supportive of the Association and has ensured an enduring spirit of cooperation and camaraderie between the Battalion and the Association. A job extremely well done and the Association wish him and his family well.

2RAR will formally transition to 2RAR (Amphib) on 15 October and the restructure will be marked by a parade on November 23 – the 69th anniversary of the Royal Australian Regiment. The Association will be formally represented at this milestone event. CO 2RAR sent the following message to the Association:

"The Battalion's 72nd birthday marks another significant milestone for the unit, transferring from the 3rd Brigade, Forces Command to Headquarters 1st Division. We have already commenced this journey in leading Army's contribution to amphibious operations. As a Battalion we look forward to the new role and challenges of generating the Australian Defence Force's specialist pre-landing force. Although smaller, we will be more agile and innovative, and provide a specialised capability. We will continue on as a Battalion as we have so far, achieving the tasks and missions set for us as quiet professionals. Thank you for your continued support.

The Association's Facebook page has developed well over the past 12 months and continues to attract considerable interest. The 2RAR website continues to be our major medium for communicating with our members. A newsletter "RINGO" is issued to our members on a quarterly basis with copies distributed within 2RAR. We are looking at

upgrading the newsletter as well as getting more input from the Battalion. It is also intended to slowly move from hard copy to electronic distribution of the newsletter.

Sadly again this year again we have farewelled almost 40 of our members. It was on ANZAC Day this year that we lost our Honorary Padre Monsignor Eugene Harley. On behalf of the Association I would like to extend my condolences to the families and friends of those who have passed away. There are also many members who continue to struggle as a result of their service to this country and our thoughts are with them as we wish them well. The committee tries to have an Association representative at all funerals for ex 2RAR members although this is not always possible. If you have information on any of our members being seriously ill or have passed away, please let the Association Secretary know as soon as possible so arrangements can be made.

The project to upgrade the 2RAR display at the VVAA Museum on Phillip Island is now complete. Max Ingles and his team are complimented on the development of this project. The 2RAR Association has set aside up to \$3000 for this upgrade. It is planned for an official opening to be held at the VVAA Museum at 1130 hrs on 21 November. All members and their guests are welcome to attend.

The Association was represented at a number of North Queensland activities during the year, which included the Regimental dinner held in Townsville in February 2017. The Association was also involved at a number of memorial services in all states throughout 2017 including ANZAC Day, Vietnam Veterans Day and Remembrance Day.

The Association remains in a sound financial position. The current membership sits at around 550 and while most of these are Vietnam veterans, we are starting to see a number of younger ex-2RAR members coming on board. The committee is developing a strategy to attract more post-Vietnam members into the Association.

Our Association representative in North Qld, Jock Cassidy, continues to work closely with 2RAR to seek ways in which the Association can support battalion activities.

- Jock has undertaken social activities for the unit with financial support from the Association
- He has arranged for a number of volunteers to assist the museum curator in further developing the museum.
 The Association also provides financial support for the unit museum.
- The Association continues to provide an annual prize for the 2RAR Champion soldier awarded during the Battalion's birthday week activities
- He has conducted fund raising activities for the Association

The Association continues to enjoy an excellent relationship with the Battalion and this is due in no small way because of the efforts of our North Qld representative. Jock is to be commended for his efforts as he continues to develop ways to further support 2RAR members and their families.

I attended the annual RAR Association conference in Melbourne recently where there was considerable discussion on the way ahead for all unit and state RAR Associations. This is an exciting time for all RAR Associations. A development plan has been prepared looking at the way ahead for the next 5-7 years and details will be placed on the website in due course.

The Association is heading in the right direction as we seek to increase the younger veteran membership base. I would like to acknowledge the ongoing dedication and hard work of the 2RAR Association committee members who through their efforts ensure that the Association continues to thrive. Without their outstanding contribution, the Association would not be where it is today.
